## ALKALI AMPHIBOLE

Exact identity not specified, possibly riebeckite (q.v.). Also referred to as sodic amphibole.

**Dickinson County:** East Branch Sturgeon River: Sodic hornblende in basalt in East Branch arkose (James et al., 1961).

**Marquette County: 1.** Magnetic mine, several miles northwest of Republic: With magnetite, grunerite, and garnet in iron formation (Lamey, 1934). **2.** Republic area: With garnet, magnetite, grunerite, and chlorite in contact zones between iron formation and diorite (Snelgrove et al., 1944).
