BASTNÄSITE-(Y) (Y,REE)(CO₃)F

Unlike its more common cerium analog, bastnäsite-(Y) is a rare mineral known from only four localities worldwide. Its occurrence in Michigan marks the first reported for the United States. Northern Peninsula.

Marquette County: Crockley pegmatite, section 22, T47N, R29W: As anhedral, reddishbrown, resinous masses up to ~ 1mm in pegmatite. Confirmed by X-ray diffraction and energy dispersion X-ray spectrometry.
