One of several nickel minerals that usually occur in certain hydrothermal nickel-cobalt-silver vein deposits. Northern Peninsula.

Keweenaw County: Mohawk mine: In veins cutting the native copper lodes. Particularly associated with domeykite, nickeline, and other arsenide minerals. Crystals 1 mm in size show the forms {001}, {100}, {230}, {011}, and {101} (Williams, 1963a; Moore and Beger, 1963).
