A rare garnet, usually found with chromite occurrences in serpentinites, but in Michigan reported only as a detrital accessory mineral in sandstone. Southern Peninsula.

Genesee County: Flushing, T8N, R5E: In the Flushing Sandstone member of Saginaw Formation (Pennsylvanian) with zoisite, tourmaline, and zircon (Kelly and Beutner, 1930).
