## **VESZELYITE**

 $(Cu^{2+}, Zn)_3(PO_4)(OH)_3 \cdot 2 H_2O$ 

A rare secondary copper mineral usually occurring in oxide zones of certain hydrothermal metal deposits. Northern Peninsula.

**Keweenaw County:** Ahmeek mine: As spiky, blue-green microcrystals with cuprite on copper (Vajdak, 2001). Identified on a specimen collected from the mine dumps in the early 1960s.
