A very rare alteration mineral previously known only from New Mexico. Thus, its occurrence in Michigan is significant. Northern Peninsula.

Dickinson County: Groveland mine: As a colorless to white, granular efflorescence on hematite. Verified by X-ray diffraction and energy dispersion X-ray spectrometry (J. Selway, personal communication, 2000).
