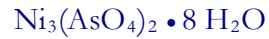


ANNABERGITE



A secondary mineral formed by supergene alteration of nickel arsenides. Northern Peninsula.

Keweenaw County: Mohawk Number 2 mine: As coatings and minute globules with other arsenates on copper arsenides in carbonate-copper veins and nickel-cobalt arsenide veins cutting native copper lodes (Moore, 1962; Moore and Beger, 1963).
