

## **BASSETITE**



A rare supergene uranium mineral. Northern Peninsula.

**Iron County:** Reported by Vickers (1956b) with other supergene uranium minerals, various sulfides, and pitchblende at the Buck iron mine.

**Marquette County:** Greens Creek slate trench, NE ¼ SE ¼ section 24, T46N, R27W: Bassetite occurs in layers of quartzite associated with metatorbernite (q.v.), dickite (or kaolinite?), pyrite and malachite (Kalliokoski, 1976).
