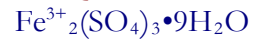
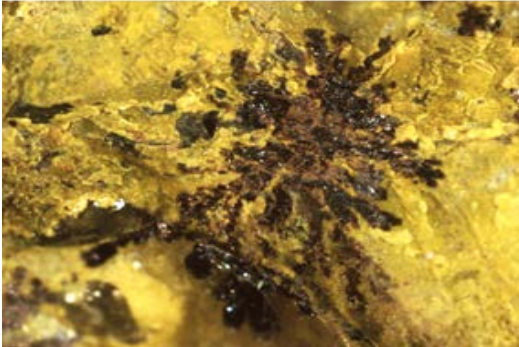


COQUIMBITE
