

CREDNERITE



Crednerite is a relatively uncommon secondary (supergene) oxide mineral. In Michigan, it has been identified from only a single occurrence: the Algoma mine, Ontonogan County, where it occurs as black, bladed, microscopic crystals, associated with zeophyllite(?) (D. Behnke, personal communication, 1994).
