

ENARGITE



Enargite is a copper sulfosalt mineral usually found in hydrothermal veins associated with porphyry copper type deposits. This is the first report of the mineral's occurrence in Michigan. Upper Peninsula.

Marquette County: Negaunee: As small, (1-4 mm) striated tabular crystals on a single specimen of crystallized pyrite with quartz and bornite. Verified by electron microprobe, X-ray diffraction and optical means. (Carlson, 2010b).
