

HALLOYSITE



A common clay mineral, often of hydrothermal origin, in altered rocks and ores. It is also found in some residual clay deposits. Northern Peninsula.

Marquette County: New Richmond iron pit, 3.6 km east of Palmer: As a cavity lining in quartz-specularite-tourmaline veins and as a fracture filling in iron ore (Ayres, 1940).
