

LUANHEITE



Like eugenite, luanheite is a very rare mercury-silver mineral known from very few localities worldwide. Its occurrence in Michigan may be the first reported from the United States. Northern Peninsula.

Menominee County: Aquila Resources, Inc. Back 40 Project, sections 1 and 12, T35N, R29W: Reported as a minor constituent in oxidized massive sulfide (gossan), though X-ray confirmation is lacking (Quigley and Mahin, 2008).
