

MAUCHERITE



A rare nickel mineral associated with other nickel and cobalt arsenides in intermediate-temperature hydrothermal veins. Northern Peninsula.

Keweenaw County: Mohawk mine: A rare constituent of the cobalt-nickel veins (P. B. Moore, personal communication).

Ontonagon County: Silver City: Reported as an accessory mineral with argentopentlandite (q.v.) in calcite (Cureton, 1989).
