

SKUTTERUDITE



Skutterudite occurs with other cobalt and nickel minerals in medium-temperature hydrothermal veins. “Smaltite” is an obsolete name for an arsenic-deficient variety. Northern Peninsula.

Keweenaw County: Mohawk mine: Arsenic-deficient skutterudite (“smaltite”) occurs with domeykite, algodonite, and other cobalt and nickel arsenide minerals in veins cutting native copper lodes.
