

# Keweenaw Mineral Days

## Registration Description and Liability Waiver

**Safety is always first for all events!**

**All collecting requires safe practices and use of common sense.  
No minors on rock piles unless registered.**

There is no general registration fee to participate in Keweenaw Mineral Days activities, but you must complete the general registration which indicates your consent to the liability release and that you will adhere wearing a facial covering/mask (medical or nonmedical grade) or practice social distancing. If you refuse to adhere to social distancing or wearing a facial covering/mask your further continuation will be terminated and there will be no refund. Registration collecting event fee is required (age 12 or older). Minors age 12 to 17 must be accompanied by and supervised by a registered adult parent or guardian. Regardless of age, all children on the rock pile must be registered to participate. A parental consent for liability form is required for children. Children under 12 years old are not allowed on the rock pile.

A registration fee is required for participation in each different collecting event. The A. E. Seaman Mineral Museum may not be open during this event due to COVID19. If it is open those registered participants in collecting events will get waived admission fee during the week of the event and 15 % discount in the gift shop.

There will be **No refund** after June 26 except for medical reasons. This year, for the overall event to be viable there must be a minimum number of requested collecting events. If the minimum is not met on or before June 26, Keweenaw Mineral Days 2020 will be cancelled.

Each of the prepared mineral collecting activities have minimum participants and may be cancelled if minimums are not met and if we cancel you get a 100 % refund. The collecting events are confirmed but should circumstances require a change we reserve the right to make a substitution of the collecting site or cancel the event with refund of your collecting event registration fee.

You will be notified via email (or phone if email is not available) of cancellations or changes and they will be posted on our Keweenaw Mineral Days web site.

Directions to each collecting site will be emailed prior to the event. Travel to events and food are the responsibility of individual participants.

### **Prepared Surface Collecting Events**

The museum has obtained legal permission to access and prepare old mine rock piles for surface collecting. You may be on the site legally ONLY during the times of the event. We contract heavy equipment (excavator) to move rock to expose new materials for collecting. The newly moved rock will be coated with fine particles, “muck”, which will make finding minerals more challenging. Your eyes are the essential tool for mineral collecting. For finding minerals such as datolite your eyes are the only tool! *For finding native copper and native silver a metal detector can be quite valuable and many would consider it essential to finding copper.* But you can find native copper without a metal detector too! Metal detectors can interfere with each other, so there can be problems when too many people have similar metal detectors too close together in a collecting area. We try to prepare sufficient area to accommodate everyone allowed on the site. We also limit the number of participants per site. We want your collecting experience to be fun and rewarding, but there is no guarantee of finding a treasure. You must provide your own **skill and luck of collecting.**
